### Artist's Responsibility

Present artwork to the committee.

Assist the committee with publicity, including press releases, newspapers, WFLC newsletter, and WFLC website. Be available for local press interviews.

Deliver artwork (must be framed with wire on back) to the Center. The committee will help hang the show. Individual artwork will be hung at the discretion of the committee.

Insure artwork (optional). The WFLC does not take responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged work.

The opening: The committee will work with the artist to help organize the opening including the setup/clean up. The artist is responsible for invitations and postage, food and drink, and paper goods.

Please Note: the ArtSpace is opened at various limited hours during the week by appointment only (visitors must call first). The artist may choose to sit their show at other times if arrangements have been made in advance with the WFLC staff.

Center will receive 10% of all sales.

Remove artwork from WFLC at an agreed time.
